








Fish Hoek Historical Timeline



Then in about 1900 it was converted into rooms for holiday accommodation when a covered stoep was added. The building is still in use as a private home, known as Mountain View.




Built about 1920, it is one of the earliest houses Built in the early 1920s, this building was first built in Fish Hoek. It was first called Airlie. For called Harmony House and was used as a holiday home for South African Railways and Harbours many years it operated as a boarding house. Today it is the popular The Victorian Times Restaurant. personnel. It later became the Milton Hotel, then The Outspan Hotel. Today it is the Outspan Lodge.



Methodist Church, First Avenue The two foundation stones were laid on 29th October, 1921, one by Mr T Mossop and the other by the Rev T E Marsh. When the Church opened in 1922 it was the first place of worship in Fish Hoek. The building is now used as a church hall.
